## Farrell runs race pushing old friend in wheelchair

Colin Farrell took time out from his acting schedule Sunday to complete the Dublin Marathon while pushing an old friend in a wheelchair.

The 48-year-old actor ran the final 2.5 miles of the 26-mile race while pushing his friend Emma



Fogarty, who lives with a rare skin condition, across the finishing line.

Farrell, who was back home in Ireland for the marathon, aimed to raise funds for DEBRA, an Irish

charity supporting people who, like Fogarty, have the incurable genetic condition epidermolysis bullosa, also known as butterfly skin.

Fogarty is Ireland's oldest surviving person with the condi-tion, according to the PA Media news agency, which said she was born with no skin on her left foot and right arm and can develop very painful blisters from even the slightest touch.
