# Federal Updates

### Government Shutdown and School Meals

- CalFresh (SNAP) benefits temporarily delayed and reduced
- School meal funding continues
- Remind families:
  - 2+ free meals per day at school
  - How to find a food bank
- Schools can donate leftover food



#### H.R. 1 and School Meals

- Some Californians will lose access or have reduced benefits under CalFresh (SNAP) and Medi-Cal (Medicaid)
- Cuts are coming in phases
- Fewer "Directly Certified" students due to cuts
- Federal contribution will decrease for California's school nutrition programs
- Every student in California will still receive free breakfast and lunch





## Micropurchases

- Micropurchase: a procurement method for small and simple purchases
- General threshold: \$10,000
- Self-certify threshold: \$50,000
- Common Uses:
  - One-time purchase
  - o First-time purchase
  - Relationship building

- **Consider:** Why might it be difficult for some farmers to sell to schools?
