





- Interim Final Rule: Rural Non-Congregate Summer Meals
- Interim Final Rule: Summer EBT
- CEP Final Rule: Lower 25% ISP
- USDA Proposed Rules: Meal Pattern Changes
- <u>SB 1383</u>: Organic Recycling & Food Recovery
- <u>SB 490</u>: CA Buy American
- <u>AB 778</u>: CA Preference in Bids
- <u>SB 348</u>: Pupil Meals (Time to Eat)
- <u>AB 95</u>: A la Carte and Second Meals (still allowed)
- <u>SB 628</u>: State Healthy Food Access in all Policies
- AB 1228: \$20 Minimum Wage for Fast Food Workers

- CDFA Farm to School Grant: \$52.8 M

- Local Foods for Schools: \$23 M




